

**Prefixes: Various Types**

**Review** A **prefix** is a word part that appears at the beginning of a base word or root to form a new word. Learn these prefixes and their meanings:

| Prefix        | Meaning                   |
|---------------|---------------------------|
| <i>en-</i>    | <i>cause to</i>           |
| <i>macro-</i> | <i>large</i>              |
| <i>magn-</i>  | <i>great</i>              |
| <i>mega-</i>  | <i>large, one million</i> |
| <i>micro-</i> | <i>small</i>              |
| <i>mini-</i>  | <i>small</i>              |
| <i>mis-</i>   | <i>bad, badly</i>         |
