THIRD-PERSON POINT OF VIEW

The **point of view** is the vantage point from which a story is narrated. When a story is told from the **third-person omniscient point of view**, the narrator is all-knowing. As a result, the narrator is aware of what all the characters in the story are thinking and doing. The narrator tells the story using the pronouns he, she, it, and they.

Directions: Use the graphic organizer to record information that Jimmy knows and information that the reader knows that Jimmy doesn't. Then answer the question that follows.

I Know

- Jimmy will spend longer in prison than he thought.
- Ben Price is out to capture Jimmy for committing robberies after his release from prison.
- There is a good chance that Ben Price will capture Jimmy because he knows his skills and moves, and there are a lot of clues.
- Prediction: Jimmy and Annabel will fall in love.

- Annabel is the one calling Jimmy at the end of the story.
- Ben knows that Jimmy has truly changed.
- I know that Annabel's father is the owner of the town bank.

How would the story be different if it were told from the first-person point of view?

Jimmy would tell the story from his point of view with what he sees, thinks, and feels. We would not know what other characters would see, think, or feel unless Jimmy actually experiences it because he doesn't know what other people think, and it would have less details than Third-Person Omniscient Point of View. First Person Point of view would be told with the pronouns I, Me, We, They, and Us.
